<p style="text-align: center;">Communication & Language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Role-play home corner / police station / cafe ● Listening to range of stories, poems etc with focus on ourselves ● Feely bag games – encouraging descriptive language ● Re-telling stories using story sacks as prompts ● Sharing family/holiday scrap books – begin to explore speaking to an audience ● Exploring prepositions on an Autumn walk ● Show & Tell 	<p style="text-align: center;">Personal, Social & Emotional development (PSED)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Introductions and building friendships ● Developing rules for Lion's Den / outdoor area ● Taking care of ourselves and our possessions ● Exploring areas of the classroom & resources ● Learning the routines of the school day ● Finding out about ourselves – what can we do? Explore stories about caring for each other through role-play, small world and puppetry. ● WOW! Time – sharing achievements from home ● Welcome! Why do we shake hands? ● Nurturing Family Links focus 	<p style="text-align: center;">Physical Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Throwing & catching games, small ball skill activities ● Developing fine motor skills with threading / cutting / malleable and construction materials ● Play games – Keeper of the keys etc ● Bikes, trikes & go-carts ● Exploring early handwriting skills using a variety of messy play activities to begin to develop letter formation 
<p style="text-align: center;">Maths</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Exploring number – ordering, counting, sorting ● Data handling – linked to bodies – colour of hair/eyes/likes/dislikes ● Pattern – repeating pattern/pattern in the environment ● Using positional language in a skeleton race ● Early addition and subtraction games ● Length investigations using non-standard measure – hand span, footprints, body ● Capacity/weight and size linked to food ● Money – exploring coins and quantities 	<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Introduce Phonic program, children participate daily in activities linked to initial sounds to begin with.
