## **End-of-course German test for First Year pupils**

As you are aware your child has been studying German so far at Abingdon. After the Christmas holidays, 1st year pupils will begin to learn French, and at the end of this academic year they will be asked to choose between the two languages and continue either French or German into the second and third year. More languages can be chosen at the end of the second year too.

French teaching will begin in the week of Monday 31 January, but beforehand all pupils will be assessed on their level in German in the form of a four-part examination. Speaking, reading, writing and listening skills will be tested in lessons in the week commencing Monday 24 January (Week B). The result of this exam will appear on your child's Lent report, and will assist in the decision making for language options into the second year.

There is a short revision guide, which will be published on the school study site, Firefly, to help your child prepare for their exam. A paper copy will also be given out. There is a lot of relevant and useful information in it, but I must stress that your child need not worry about this exam and should not over-prepare for it. The pupils will all do revision in class in the week prior to the exam.
