Dear Parents and Guardians,

I am pleased to announce that we have been able to secure 2 days of pre-season tennis training in the first week of the Easter holidays. This will be provided free of charge and will take place on the **Monday 4 and Tuesday 5 April**. All coaching will be on the MUSA at the main school site. We have great depth in the club and there are excellent players across multiple year groups. In order to make the sessions as valuable as possible we will group players by ability. Please see details below regarding the proposed timings. Your child would need to be available on both days and groups will be decided once we have the full sign up list.
