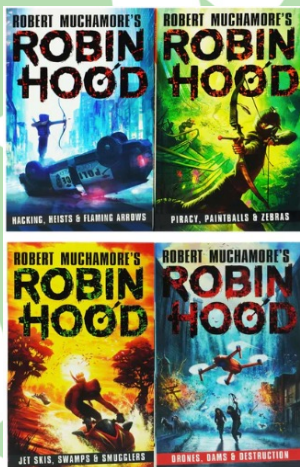

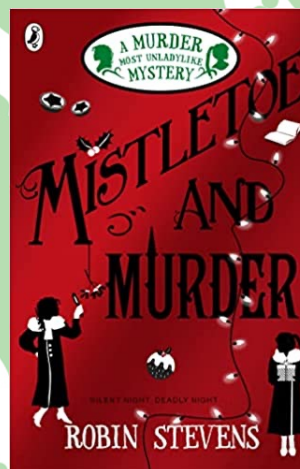
Festive thrills

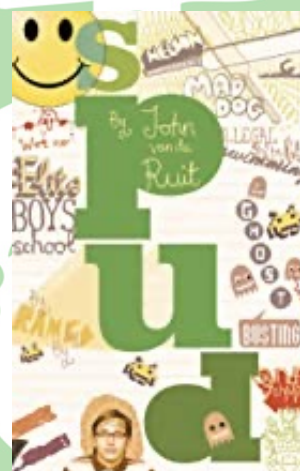
Seasonal scares



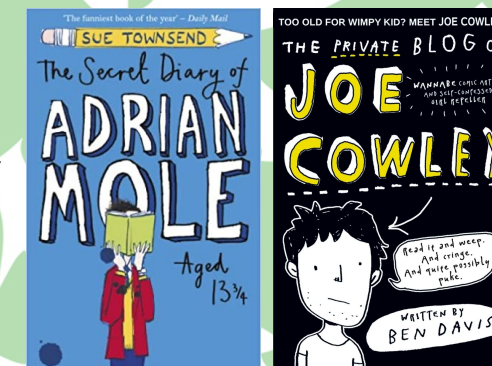
