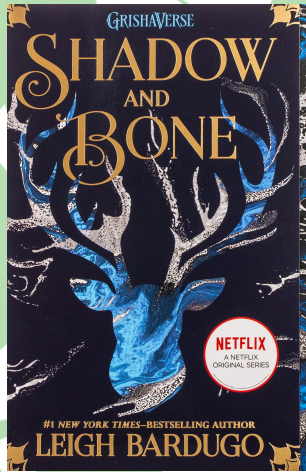

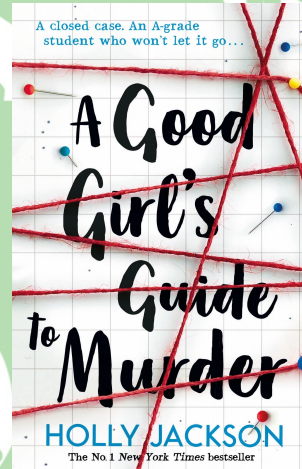
Festive fantasy



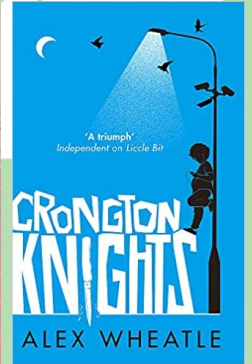
When a teenage soldier unleashes dormant magic not even she knew she possessed, she's taken in by her country's military elite – where she discovers a secret that could bring her world to an end.

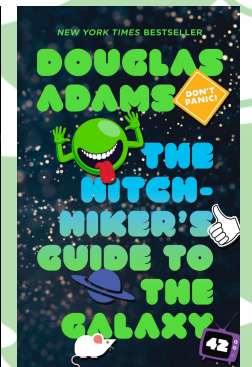
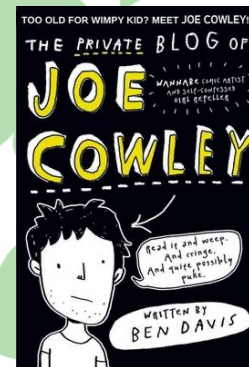
A teenager who can see the future...and another searching desperately for answers. They're separated by fifteen years, yet their fates will collide, on the streets of South London - and in the Upper World...
