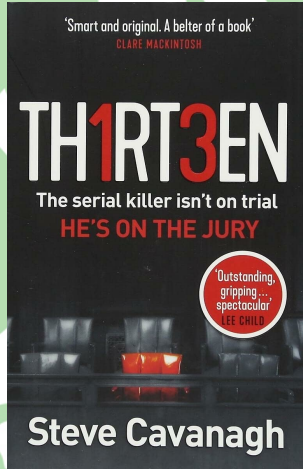


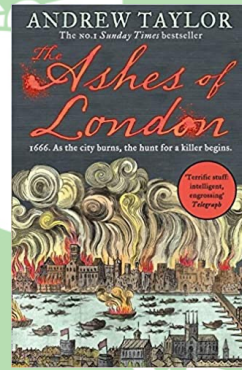

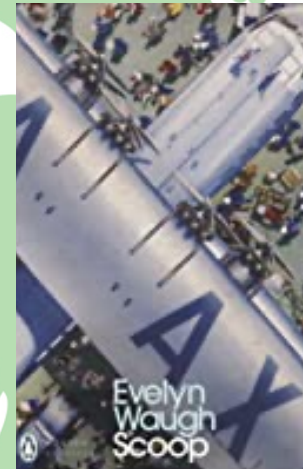
Christmas crime

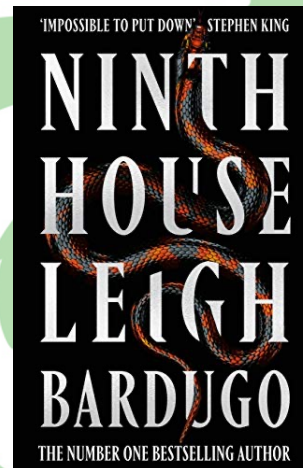
Seasonal science fiction
